

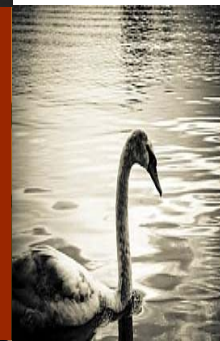

Transportation & Housing Resources

- The Jim Day Housing Scholarship Fund awards two \$500 scholarships each fall to returning undergraduates with financial need.
- Year-around housing options are available
- UGA Bus Service and Athens Transit are both free to students
- Fresh Bus Service available on Saturdays to the farmer's market

Health & Wellness Resources

- ASPIRE Clinic services include individual and family therapy as well as financial counseling including Vista tax prep help
- Counseling and Psychiatric Services (CAPS) provides therapy and medication management
- CRC- for recovering alcoholics, addicts, & eating disorders
- CCPE in Aderhold College of Education- sliding scale individual and group assessment work
- The Psychology Clinic offers individual and group therapy
- Student Care and Outreach assists students experiencing hardships

Social and Leisure Resources

- Career Center provides assistance with a variety of career ready concerns including resume building, job searches, and choosing a major
- LGBTQ Resource Center
- Films are shown at the Tate Center and are free for students
- UGA Recreation Sports offers many opportunities
