



## Is Seeking Applicants for Two Temporary Assistant Professors Beginning Fall, 2008

The University of Georgia, School of Social Work (SSW) is seeking to hire two, 12-month Temporary Assistant Professors for the continuation and expansion of the Child Welfare Title IV-E Education Program. These Temporary Assistant Professors will teach up to 7 courses divided between fall, spring, and summer semesters, assist with practica placements, serve as advisors to Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS) employees in the MSW program, provide liaison services to grantee students in their DFCS concentration internship, and coordinate DFCS presentations in classes. These faculty members will also recruit MSW students for subsequent cohorts via presentations to DFCS staff and champion DFCS employment among students. Faculty members are expected to attend monthly faculty meetings and DFCS/University consortium meetings in Macon.

**Requirements for positions** include a doctorate in Social Work or closely related field and an MSW (or may be ABD with an MSW and has compensatory social work experience). The School is seeking individuals to teach across the MSW curriculum in Gwinnett and Athens, including the part-time MSW program in Athens. Responsibilities include teaching, field liaison, and organizational service. Practice experience in child welfare preferred as well as prior teaching experience at the graduate level. Previous experience with on-line teaching is also desired.
