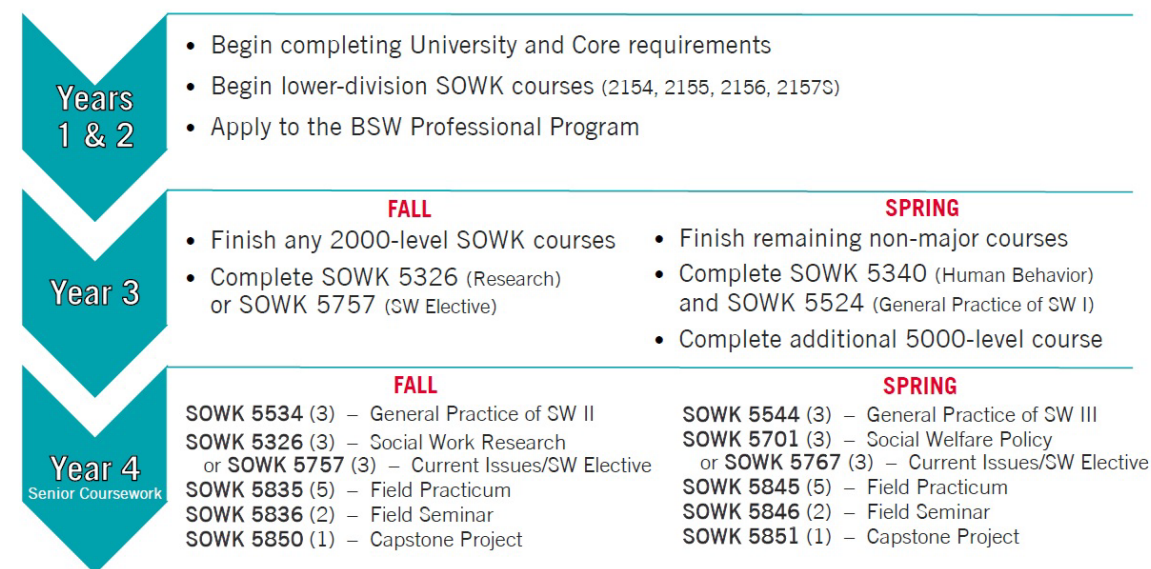




Typical Course Sequencing
