Program Requirements

- Selected students will have their field placement in a DBHDD or Community
 Service Board agency (like Advantage in Athens) Students commit to working at
- least 12 months post-graduation at a DBHDD or CSB agency
 Students will participate in a 1 credit per semester seminar course exploring relevant topics
- Students agree to obtain their LMSW following graduation
